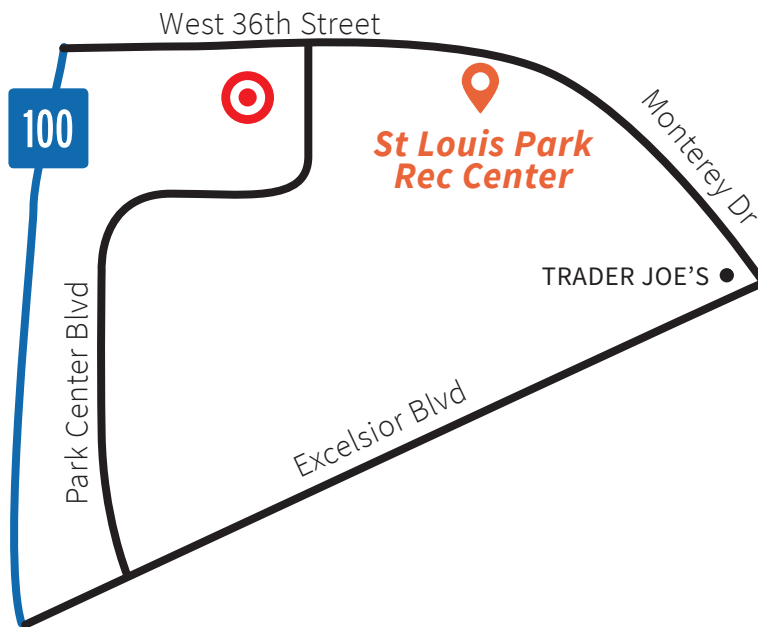
DIRECTIONS

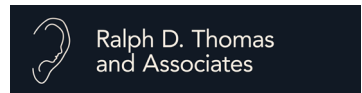
